Buttermilk Creek descends more than 500 feet in a series of cascades and rapids. A natural pool at the base of Buttermilk Falls provides swimming with the feel of an old swimming hole. Upstream, a scenic trail circles Lake Treman. The park features 5 trails that wander through a remarkable variety of landscapes. Visible from the state park entrance, cascading Buttermilk Falls is the largest of 10 falls along Buttermilk Creek as it plunges 600 feet to the valley.

“Experience! The Finger Lakes of the Fabulous Falls Above Cayuga Tour”

Your guide will take you to the famous Cornell Suspension bridge—a pedestrian bridge that is suspended 138 feet above the water—followed by two other falls surrounding College Town and Cascadilla Park. The tour culminates with an up-close-and-personal visit to Ithaca Falls, downtown Ithaca’s own 135 foot waterfall. In addition to exploring beautiful waterfalls and The Cornell University campus, your guide will weave stories of Ithaca’s history and classic tales of Cornell throughout the tour. The end result will be an intimate experience of our unique and “gorges” town. In addition stop at the Cayuga Lake front and Stewart Park, where you will learn more about the lake itself, how the park used to be home to a silent movie production company that brought all the big movie stars of the time – Irene Castle, Lionel Barrymore, Mary Pickford – to Ithaca.

Wine Tasting at Six Mile Creek Vineyard

Six Mile Creek’s tasting room resides inside the Dutch Colonial Barn and offers a welcoming environment to sample wines and spirits from the Finger Lakes. The inside of the barn, which underwent extensive remodeling in 1997, includes a large tasting room and deck overlooking the vineyard.

Ice Cream at Purity Ice Cream

Ithaca, an area long known as a dining hotspot, has extensive history and documentation supporting the ice cream sundae's creation here in 1892. The information is so specific, the city can almost pinpoint the exact hour the first ice cream "Sunday" was served. While other cities may claim the sundae, none can support its claim with primary evidence. This gives Ithaca title to the first documented ice cream sundae in the United States. Known as “The Ice Cream of the Finger Lakes”, Purity has been providing original recipe, small batch ice cream to Central New York for generations.
