Elms Mansion – Viewing of Authentic 19th Century Coaches

Enjoy viewing authentic 19th century coaches drawn by matched & highly trained teams of horses as they parade on the grounds of the Elms Mansion, celebrating & preserving a century-old sporting tradition. The tradition of coaching grew out of the 18th and 19th century mail runs in England, which later made their way across the Atlantic to the United States. The horse-drawn mail coaches were eventually replaced by railroads, but nostalgia led to the development of coaching as a sport. The Coaching Club of New York was formed in the latter part of the 19th century, eventually becoming part of the social fabric of Newport in the summer.
