The National Cherry Blossom Festival a three-week, citywide springtime festival celebrates the 1912 gift of 3,000 cherry trees to Washington, DC by the mayor of Tokyo. The festival features a range of spectacular events. Local restaurants even get into the spirit with the Cherry Picks program, featuring cherry blossom-themed food and drink items.

The average peak bloom date, when 70% of the flowers of the cherry blossom trees are open, is April 4. In the past, peak bloom has occurred as early as March 15 and as late as April 18, according to the National Park Service. As a reminder, please, do your part in helping to protect the National Mall by never picking the cherry blossoms (it's against the law).

The Smithsonian Institute is on the National Mall. Admission to the buildings is free. Buildings include: National Museum of American Indian, Freer Gallery of Art, The Castle or the Smithsonian Institution Building, National Portrait Gallery, National Museum of American Art, Hirshhorn Museum and Sculpture Garden, Anacostia Neighborhood Museum, Arts and Industries Building, National Gallery of Art, National Museum of Natural History, Renwick Gallery, National Air and Space Museum, National Museum of African Art and National Museum of American History.
