One Liberty Observation Deck: See it all from 57 stories up. Be at the center of it all with Philly's newest attraction. You will become part of Philadelphia's iconic skyline when you see Philly from the Top at One Liberty Observation Deck, Philadelphia's tallest enclosed observation deck. It provides 360 views, 365 days a year. And it's located in the heart of Center City Philadelphia, within walking distance to other major attractions. From William Penn to Rocky and beyond, this guided tour will highlight the story of Philadelphia's History. Once you step out of the elevator and are hit with a view of Philadelphia like you've never seen before, you'll understand why the Observation Deck is the ideal place to visit.

The Shops at Liberty Place boasts 42 brand name stores, 16 food court options and 2 restaurants.

Museum of the American Revolution: Enjoy a journey through the remarkable story of America's founding and gain a deeper understanding of the people, events, and ideals that gave birth to the nation. Located just steps from Independence Hall in the heart of Historic Philadelphia, the Museum brings the stories of our nation's founding to life in exciting and unique ways.

National Constitution Center is a nonprofit, nonpartisan institution devoted to the United States Constitution. On Independence Mall in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, the center is an interactive museum and a national town hall for constitutional dialogue, hosting government leaders, journalists, scholars, and celebrities for public discussions. The center houses the Annenberg Center for Education and Outreach, which offers civic learning resources onsite and online. It does not house the original Constitution, which is stored at the National Archives Building in Washington, D.C.

The National Constitution Center's main exhibits include three attractions: *FREEDOM RISING*, a multimedia theatrical production, presented in the all-new SIDNEY KIMMEL THEATER; *THE STORY OF WE THE PEOPLE*, an interactive exhibit; and the iconic *SIGNERS' HALL*, with 42 life-size, bronze statues of the Founding Fathers. Photography and video of any kind are prohibited in the museum exhibit areas, with the exception of Signers' Hall.
