Now a historic site of the National Trust for Historic Preservation, this extraordinary landmark has been continuously and meticulously maintained for more than 100 years. Visitors enjoy the elegant rooms, expansive, beautifully kept gardens and the collection of carriages and classic autos.

Guided Tour of Historic Huguenot Street

In 1678, a group of Huguenot families established a community in the Hudson Valley of New York in the hope of creating a home where they could worship as they chose. In 1894, their descendants formed what is now Historic Huguenot Street to protect their legacy in the buildings, objects, and stories they left behind. Today, the 10-acre National Historic Landmark District includes a Visitor Center, seven historic stone houses, a reconstructed 1717 Huguenot church, exhibit and program spaces, archaeological sites, and a burial ground that dates to the very first settlers. Huguenot Street also maintains an extensive archive that preserves early local history collections and family papers, along with a research library.

Wine tasting at Whitecliff Vineyard

Whitecliff Vineyard is an artisanal family run winery created from the ground up by owners and founders. Whitecliff is currently one of the largest vineyards in the Hudson Valley, with over 20 varieties of grapes planted for their continuing effort to refine their growing and winemaking.

West Point Military Academy Tour (Photo ID is required for all over the age 16)

On this tour, our guide tells the story of West Point, its role in the Revolution, its famous history, along with stories about graduates who shaped our nation. The tour will bring the Long Gray Line to the present as you learn of the cadet experience and West Point's continuing role in training the leaders of tomorrow. The tour includes stops at the Cadet Chapel, the Plain which is the Cadet academic area, and Trophy Point with the million dollar view overlooking the Hudson River.
