The Maine Department of Corrections operates Industries Programs in five of our Adult Facilities. The goal is to provide quality products to the public and other agencies while, very importantly, keeping as many prisoners busy as possible. With average program revenues exceeding 1.5 million annually, Industries is primarily a self-funded operation and has been described by Washington D.C. consultants as “Unique to the Nation”. This highly regulated program enables participating prisoners to earn money which goes toward reimbursing the state for their room and board expenses, as well as paying victim restitution and child support. \*Store is not located in prison.

Camden is a picturesque town in midcoastal Maine, nestled at the foot of Camden Hills on Penobscot Bay. Its slogan is “Where the Mountains Meet the Sea” and is considered by many visitors to be one of the most beautiful places in New England. Camden, Maine is also an affluent town, with many wealthy families owning properties in the area. It has a population of 5,254. Although the town is considered affluent, it still has a small town sensibility, with friendly people, and gorgeous views and preserved buildings and historic structures.
