**Philadelphia Zoo:** The Philadelphia Zoo is home to over 1300 animals including more than 300 different species and subspecies. Exhibits are indoor & outdoor. The Philadelphia Zoo's 42 acre campus is filled with a variety of animal habitats. Each habitat is designed to provide you and your family with an up close and personal experience. Exhibits - **Africans Plains, Monkey Junction, Big Cat Falls, Primate Reserve, Bear Country, Bird Valley, Reptile and Amphibian House, Carnivore Kingdom, Small Mammal House, KidszooU and McNeil Avian Center.**

**Food:** Indoor and outdoor food concessions offer a variety of eating options. The Zoo also maintains picnic areas at several picturesque outdoor locations. Guests are permitted to bring their own food and drink; however, alcohol is prohibited on Zoo grounds.

**Adventure Aquarium** is located in Camden NJ. Walk into the Adventure Aquarium and you'll hear the rubele of a massive rainforest waterfall. Rising up two full stories, the **Irazu Falls** pours over 400 gallons of water into a deep, freshwater pool filled with hundreds of Amazon River fish. Step foot into the **West African River Experience** featuring massive hippopotamuses (Button & Genny), crocodiles, porcupine and a free-flight aviary with more than 20 different species of birds flying overhead.

Travel into the depths of the ocean and explore the wonders of the deep sea in the **Jules Verne Gallery**. Surround yourself in the 40 foot floor to ceiling, walk-through tunnel as 24 sand bar, sand tiger and nurse sharks surround you in the 550,000 gallon **Shark Realm**.

Walk through the **Caribbean Currents** with each of the fifteen different exhibits filled with exotic and amazing creatures that are best described as other-worldly. There is a hands-on creature lab, a giant tow story Amazon Waterfall, penguin and seal exhibits, and a thrilling touch-a-shark attraction. Additional exhibits & shows: Ocean Realm, Seal Shores, Penguin Island, Touch-A-Shark, Creature Feature, Rainforest Rendezvous and Feather Ridge.

**Food:** Feeding Frenzy Cafe is a self-serve restaurant and has indoor and outdoor seating. Food and drink are not permitted in the Aquarium. Aquarium is handicapped accessible.
