Lake Tobias Wildlife Park - Since 1965 Lake Tobias Wildlife Park has been fascinating patrons with its wild, exotic animals and adventure-seeking safari tours. Nestled in the quiet countryside, Lake Tobias resounds with the sight and sounds of the jungles and grasslands of six continents. Animals, reptiles and birds from around the world can be found here.

Our wildlife park is both a zoo and a functioning farm. Employees work the 300 acres of farmland to grow food that feeds the hoofed stock. Some of our animals roam freely throughout the park, such as chickens, peacocks, and guineas. Lake Tobias also offers a variety of shows and exhibitions designed to educate and entertain visitors. Patrons often enjoy getting a real-life glimpse of what it's like to manage and sustain a large wildlife park.

Hundreds of animals reside along 50 acres of exhibits and displays at our wildlife park. These exhibits include African lions, American black bears, baboons, Bengal tigers, monkeys, ostriches, kangaroos, American alligators, pythons, tortoises, llamas, camels, alpacas, zebras, and more. The lions, bears, tigers, and baboons are housed in some of our most spacious, exciting, and recently renovated exhibits. The reptile and exotics building isn't just home to snakes and lizards; it also houses many other animals such as critically-endangered tamarins, exotic marmosets, tropical birds, a sloth, lemurs, and a few surprises!

The petting zoo allows visitors to feed and pet goats, alpacas, camels, and llamas. At the Reptiles & Exotics Facility, you can see eye-opening presentations on fascinating creatures and even touch an alligator if you dare. The feeding of alligators is one of our more popular attractions. This takes place at the outdoor alligator exhibit on Sundays at approximately 4 p.m., provided the alligators feel warm enough to feed.

Patrons can explore the park at their leisure to learn and be entertained by hundreds of creatures. Visitors should allocate about one hour to see the different exhibits.

Safari Tours - The main attraction at Lake Tobias Wildlife Park. Specially designed, open-air cruisers take you across 150 acres of rolling hills where you'll see herds of wild and exotic animals from around the world. Tour guides travel with you through pasture land and wooded areas giving expert information on the various species and their habitats. Approximately 500 head of mammals and flightless birds, which may vary daily, are on the tour. You will be amazed at how close you will come to these animals. Please note: Children under 13 years of age must be accompanied by an adult.
