The Breakers is the grandest of Newport's summer "cottages" and a symbol of the Vanderbilt family's social and financial preeminence in turn of the century America. The Breakers was built in just two years (1893-1895) at a cost of over 7 million dollars (equivalent to over \$150 million today). The 70-room mansion has a gross area of 125,339 square feet and 62,482 square feet of living area on five floors.
