**Self-guided tour of the Breakers Mansion**

The Breakers is the grandest of Newport's summer "cottages" and a symbol of the Vanderbilt family's social and financial preeminence in turn of the century America. The Breakers was built in just two years (1893-1895) at a cost of over 7 million dollars (equivalent to over \$150 million today). The 70-room mansion has a gross area of 125,339 square feet and 62,482 square feet of living area on five floors.

◆ **Self-guided audio tour of Rosecliff Mansion**

Architect Stanford White modeled this mansion after the Grand Trianon, the garden retreat of French Kings at Versailles. The magnificent ballroom, the largest in Newport, was the site of fabulous parties hosted by silver heiress Tessie Oelrichs. Rosecliff has been the setting for several movies including *The Great Gatsby*, *True Lies*, *Amistad* and *27 Dresses*.
