Guided Tour to Provincetown

Provincetown is at the northern tip of Cape Cod, Massachusetts. The seaside town is on the site of the Mayflower's landing in 1620.

Photo stop at Pilgrim's First Landing Park
Pilgrim Monument and Provincetown Museum

The monument is the tallest granite tower in the United States and commemorates the historic Pilgrim landing. Climb 252 steps and enjoy panoramic views from the tower. The museum's exhibits feature pilgrim and maritime history, whaling, and the early days of modern American theater in Provincetown.

Lunch and free time in Provincetown
Dune Tour

Imagine dunes stretching as far as you can see with wispy beach grass, dark green pine trees and deep red beach plums nestled in hollows which are brought together by a silhouette of blue sky. You will travel through the majestic dunes where your guide points out the "dune shacks" where famous artists and writers like Eugene O'Neill and Harry Kemp became inspired to create their art. You will also pass the remains of the Peaked Hill Life Saving Station and learn how the brave "life savers" enacted their heroic efforts to save the lives of thousands from the doomed shipwrecks. You will be amazed at what you will see on this incredibly scenic sand dune tour.

Driving tour of the Outer Cape

The area explored by the Pilgrims during their five-week stay in Provincetown. Stop at First Encounter Beach where Pilgrims scouting a settlement location were met by native American shouts and arrows! At Corn Hill the Pilgrims found and seized sites of interest include "Cape Cod Light", commissioned by George Washington and the first light station on Cape Cod (beautiful ocean views from the Observation Deck, overlooking the Atlantic.)

Tour a full-scale reproduction of the Pilgrim's ship. Learn about the 1620 voyage, the perils of maritime travel, and explore the passengers cramped quarters below.

Pilgrim Hall Museum

The Pilgrim Hall museum houses an unmatched collection of Pilgrim possessions, telling the story of brave and determined men and women building lives in a new world. View William Bradford's Bible, Myles Standish's sword, the cradle of New England's first-born, Peregrine White, and the earliest sampler made in America, embroidered by Myles Standish's daughter.

Lunch on own along the Plymouth waterfront

Plimoth Plantation

Explore the Plimoth Plantation -the 1627 Pilgrim Village, and the Native American Wampanoag Homesite. At the Homesite you will interact with modern day Native Americans in traditional clothing as they practice time honored skills. In the Pilgrim Village costumed interpreters re-enact life in 1627 performing daily tasks, cooking, harvesting, gardening, and tending farm animals giving you fascination insight into Pilgrim life in the New World! At the Visitor's Center view an orientation film, shop at the museum store and enjoy special exhibits.

Cranberry Bog Tour at A.D. Makepeace

Visit A.D. Makepeace, the world's largest cranberry grower! Travel on the bus with a guide to the cranberry bog areas. Stops are included where you will get off the bus for an up close look at a bog in production. Every effort is made to show wet harvesting in detail. Learn about the yearly cycle of cranberry growing, the methods of harvesting and insight on being a cranberry farmer.
