Intrepid Sea, Air & Space Museum Complex is a dynamic, interactive and educational journey for all ages. The museum’s mission is to honor our heroes, educate the public and inspire our youth.

Aircraft Carrier Intrepid - Launched in 1943, the aircraft carrier USS *Intrepid* fought in World War II, surviving five kamikaze attacks and one torpedo strike. The ship later served in the Cold War and Vietnam. *Intrepid* also served as a NASA recovery vessel in the 1960s. *Intrepid* was decommissioned in 1974.

The **Space Shuttle Pavilion** showcases the space shuttle *Enterprise*, the prototype NASA orbiter that paved the way for the space shuttle program. Seventeen dynamic exhibit zones feature original artifacts, photographs, audio, and films.

The **USS Growler** is the only American diesel-powered strategic missile submarine open to the public. The Growler offers museum visitors a firsthand look at life aboard a submarine and a close-up inspection of the once “top-secret” missile command center.

Handicapped Access – Intrepid offers handicapped access via elevators to the Hangar Deck and Flight Deck from Pier 86 and Third Deck. The Concorde and the Growler are NOT wheelchair accessible.

Dining – There are concessions available on the grounds to purchase food.
