**Get Around the Inner Harbor on the Baltimore Water Taxi** - For ideal transportation in and around Baltimore's Inner Harbor, the water taxi is an affordable solution. One price buys unlimited rides for the day and group discount rates are available. Ticketing is located on Lancaster Street.

**Shop 'til You Drop at Harborplace and The Gallery** located in the heart of the Inner Harbor on Pratt Street, Harborplace and The Gallery offer unique shopping, diverse dining and a variety of entertainment right on the picturesque waterfront.
