PA Governor's Residence – Docent lead guided tour of the PA Governor's Residence.

Historic Broad Street Market – The Broad Street Market was founded in 1860, and has the distinction of being the oldest continuously operated market house in the United States. During the Civil War, farmers at the Broad Street Market helped feed the 300,000 Union soldiers who mustered at nearby Camp Curtin.

Pride of Susquehanna Riverboat Cruise – Narrated river cruise. The **Pride of the Susquehanna Riverboat** is an authentic stern-driven paddle wheel riverboat built 28 years ago as a community service project by the Harrisburg Area Riverboat Society for the benefit of and visitors to the Harrisburg, Pennsylvania area.

PA State Capitol Building – Docent lead guided tour.

****SECURITY****

Security check points include passing through a metal detector. Upon occasion security screening may require whole body pat-downs.
