The Cyclorama, Film and Museum Experience includes the film, A New Birth of Freedom; the massive Cyclorama painting, which literally surrounds visitors with a magnificent visual of the fury of Pickett's Charge, and the Gettysburg Museum of the American Civil War, featuring 12 exhibit galleries that contain artifacts and interactive displays.

Battlefield Tour: Experience countless stories and breathtaking landmarks, terrain, vistas and monuments on a 2 hour tour with a Licensed Battlefield Guide, who is licensed by the National Park Service as an historic interpreter of the major events for the three day Battle of Gettysburg.
