Beach Tags: Beach tags are required to stay on the beach from Memorial Day to Labor Day for anyone 12 & older. Seasonal, weekly and daily passes are available at the Welcome Center (16 E 9th Street), City Hall, Music Pier or at any guarded beach entrance.

Beach rules: Swimming is only allowed where the beaches are guarded by lifeguards.

Restrooms: There are public facilities throughout the island. Find them on the Boardwalk at 1st, 6th and 12th Street and in the Music Pier, and on the beach at 34th and 58th Street.

Bathhouse: Here you can shower for a small fee after a day on the beach. The bathhouse is located at 13th Street and Boardwalk.

Alcohol: Ocean City is a dry town! That means no alcohol sale or consumption is permitted in any public place, including the beach.

Welcome Center: You will find brochures, coupons, helpful hints and information on things to do.

The Boardwalk: Offers visitors an opportunity to try delicious foods, browse through souvenir and novelty shops, play miniature golf, and enjoy all the fun and excitement the boardwalk has to offer.
