



## ***Our Extreme Clean Commitment: Cleaning, Disinfecting, and Protection***



To ensure best practices are followed, Trans-Bridge Lines has put the following practices in place for maintaining clean buses:

- Passengers are not permitted to occupy the first four (4) seats in the coach (seats 1-4) unless instructed by Trans-Bridge management.
- Disinfecting of 26 visible touch points including handrails, door latches, window release bars, driver area and restroom surfaces, including door handles, before tour travel. This is accomplished by total motorcoach cleaning and disinfectant wiping.
- Trans-Bridge Lines treats buses with SurfaceWise<sup>®2</sup>, an EPA-approved antiviral solution, which kills 99.9% of viruses, including coronaviruses on surfaces. Once applied, it forms a highly durable coating that is effective for 90 days, even on high-touch surfaces.
- Trans-Bridge Lines has replaced the standard main filters on our MCI motorcoaches with the MCI MERV 8 filter. The MERV 8 filter provides protection in capturing respiratory droplets and fine particles in the air.
- Passenger cabin air is completely exchanged with fresh, outside air approximately every 10 minutes. There is a separate air system for the driver cockpit area.
- Trans-Bridge requires face coverings to be worn while on board our motorcoaches or as directed by federal, state and local agencies.

Face coverings of any kind, hand sanitizer, disinfectant wipes, and any other personal protection equipment will be the responsibility of passengers.
