The roots of The Reg Lenna Center for the Arts reach back as far as the Roaring Twenties. The theater now operated by The Reg was first opened in Jamestown, New York, on February 5, 1923, as The Palace Theatre – a “high-class vaudeville house.” One of The Palace’s finest moments came in 1956 when it hosted the world premiere of “Forever, Darling,” starring Desi Arnaz and Lucille Ball. The comedy couple visited Jamestown, Ball’s birthplace, to attend the screening, drawing thousands of adoring fans downtown and to the theater to welcome the Hollywood stars in their Western New York visit.
