Ocean City, NJ & Alcohol Rules

Ocean City, NJ is located about 30 minutes south of Atlantic City is known as “America’s Greatest Family Resort.” There are 2 ½ miles of white sandy beaches.

Ocean City is a dry town! That means no alcohol sale, or consumption permitted in any public place, including the beach.

Beach Tags & Beach Rules

Beach tags are required to stay on the beach from Memorial Day to Labor Day for anyone 12 & older. Seasonal, weekly and daily passes are available at the Welcome Center (16 E 9th Street), City Hall, and Music Pier or at any guarded beach entrance.

Swimming only allowed where lifeguards guard the beaches.

The Boardwalk

Offers visitors an opportunity to try delicious foods, browse through souvenir and novelty shops, play miniature golf, and enjoy all the fun and excitement the boardwalk has to offer.

Restrooms & Bathhouse

There are public facilities throughout the island. Find them on the Boardwalk at 1st, 6th, and 12th Street and in the Music Pier, and on the beach at 34th and 58th Street.

The bathhouse is located at 13th Street and Boardwalk. Here you can shower for a small fee after a day on the beach.
