The 2022 Induction Ceremony will take place at 1:30 p.m. ET Sunday, July 24, on the grounds of the Clark Sports Center (outdoor area) on Susquehanna Ave just one-mile south of the Hall of Fame. The Old/Former inductees, who are present, will be introduced first before the new inductees. There is a shuttle that operates between the Hall of Fame and the Induction ceremony. The shuttle does get crowded; it is about a 15-minute walk from the Hall of Fame.
