Where to Eat: Food can be purchased at the Flower Show throughout the Pennsylvania Convention Center. There are Snack Bars at the rear of the main exhibit hall, and full dining services location on Level 3 above the exhibition halls in the Overlook Café. You will also find numerous restaurants in the area immediately surrounding the Convention Center, including Reading Terminal Market and in nearby Chinatown.

Free Re-entry: Visitors can re-enter the show on the same day free. Need to have hand stamped.

Handicap Accessibility: The Pennsylvania Convention Center is a handicap accessible building. Elevators are available to guests who require them. Wheelchairs are available for rent on a first-come first-served basis.
