 Hancock Shaker Village – lunch and time on own

Hancock Shaker Village is a landmark destination of 750 acres, 20 historic Shaker buildings, and over 22,000 Shaker artifacts. On the National Historic Register, it is the most comprehensively interpreted Shaker site in the world, and the oldest working farm in the Berkshires of Western Massachusetts. The land now known as Hancock Shaker Village is on the western edge of an area once called “Pontoosuck,” a Mohican word meaning “field or haven for winter deer.” Explore the power of their religious beliefs, the echo of their song and everyday routine, the splendor of their gardens, and the simple beauty and efficiency of their architecture, furniture, and tools.

Glendale Ridge Vineyards

A visit to Glendale Ridge Vineyard is a unique experience, as it provides a close look into the winemaking process from vine to bottle. Located in beautiful Western Massachusetts, close to the Berkshires, is Glendale Ridge Vineyard. A farm built in the 1860s, this is the site of 5 acres of vines that are grown, processed and fermented into our estate wines. We also source fruit carefully from Long Island and the Finger Lakes Region.

Guided House Tour at The Mount - Edith Wharton’s Home

Visit Pulitzer Prize-winning author Edith Wharton’s home. Here, she wrote some of her most famous novels including Ethan Frome and The House of Mirth. Visitors are encouraged to sit and interact with the rooms. Interpretive exhibits throughout the house explore Wharton’s life, her humanitarian efforts, literary legacy, and lives of the servants.

Lunch on own in downtown Stockbridge
Norman Rockwell Museum

The Museum houses the world's largest and most significant collection of Rockwell's work, including 998 original paintings and drawings. Rockwell lived in Stockbridge for the last 25 years of his life. On the Museum's scenic 36-acre site, enjoy a walk with stunning Berkshire vistas, including gardens, specimen trees, plants (identified with labels), and our sculptures created by Norman Rockwell's son Peter; meander through our field paths to the Housatonic River, or pick an apple from trees planted for each Rockwell grandchild.
