Guided Tour of Assateague Island "Home of the Wild Ponies"

Assateague's wild horses are well known, even to many people who have never been to the island. The "wild" horses on Assateague are actually feral animals, meaning that they are descendants of domestic animals that have reverted to a wild state. Horses tough enough to survive the scorching heat, abundant mosquitoes, stormy weather and poor quality food found on this remote, windswept barrier island have formed a unique wild horse society. Enjoy their beauty from a distance, and you can help make sure these extraordinary wild horses will continue to thrive on Assateague Island.

Harriet Tubman Underground Railroad Visitor's Center

The Harriet Tubman Underground Railroad Visitor Center opened to the public in March 2017 in Church Creek on Maryland's Eastern Shore. Harriet Tubman, who grew up in slavery in Dorchester County, lived, worked, and worshipped in places near the visitor center. It's from this area that she first escaped slavery, and where she returned about 13 times over a decade, risking her life time and again to lead some 70 friends and family members to freedom. To carry out the dangerous missions, she used the Underground Railroad, a secret network of places and people.

Guided tour of the Blackwater Refuge & Bucktown Store

We will ride along the Blackwater Refuge to view the terrain she traveled in her escapes. Bucktown Store is where Harriet sustained the famous injury that she said led her on her mission.
