On this 2 hour guided tour, you'll tour Broadway where all the action takes place. View the gorgeous mansions and the how and why people settled here. Drive by the two historic racetracks and learn how horse racing began in the 1820s. Enjoy the history of the famous Triple Crown winners and a stop for Mineral Water tasting. Learn the health, wealth and history of the spas and the famous people that came to Saratoga in the 1800s to current day times. View the statues of Sea Biscuit and Native Dancer. Hear the stories of the people attached to the history of Gambling to Prohibition that changed Saratoga forever.

This riding tour includes a tour of the Village to include history of the Mohawk and Hurons Indians, Father Iassac Joques, Fort William Henry, Fort George and Battleground Park. There will be photo stops along the lake and learn the geology of the Adirondack Mountains. Plus, a trip up Prospect Mountain (*weather depending*). Take a 6-mile ride to the Summit with stops along the way. Learn about the Cable Railway and the Prospect Mountain House built in the early days of hotels and rail transportation.

Luncheon Cruise aboard the Lac du Saint Sacrement

The 190 foot long Lac du Saint Sacrement is the largest cruise ship on the inland waters of New York State. Entertainment and narration are both included aboard the Saint Sacrement meal cruises.

Tour of Fort William Henry Museum

History comes alive at Fort William Henry. Experience the history, the sights and sounds of the fort during the French and Indian War. Discover 18th century living in 1757 as two world powers fought for control of North America. The tour includes a historical presentation by Guides in period clothing followed by military demonstrations of a period replica of a musket and cannon.
