Gari Melchers Home and Studio, also known as Belmont, is a National Historic Landmark and historic house museum in Falmouth, Virginia. This much-altered 18th-century house was the home and studio of the popular American artist Gari Melchers and his wife, Corinne, from 1916 until his death. This 27-acre estate features the historic home, art studio and galleries, tours, gardens, historic buildings and several miles of walking trails.

 Guided Tour of Richmond with stop at St. John's Church

On this tour, the guide covers the length and breadth of the greater downtown and surrounding neighborhoods of Richmond, with a stop and tour at historic St. John's Church. St John's Church in Richmond, Virginia, is one of America's most important historic sites, where - swayed by Patrick Henry's powerful argument - the delegates made a decision that changed the course of history, lighting the spark of the War for Independence. *Here, Patrick Henry embodied the spirit of the Revolution on March 23, 1775, with his words, "Give me liberty...or give me death!"*

 Lunch on own at Shockoe Slip

Known for its scenic, cobblestone streets, Shockoe Slip is home to some of Richmond's most beloved and long-standing Shockoe Slip restaurants and small businesses, the Kanawha Canal, creative businesses like the Martin Agency and many of downtown RVA's hotels. Shockoe Slip is a must-see part of downtown Richmond for locals and visitors to see all of the best that Richmond has to offer.

American Civil War Museum & White House Confederacy

American Civil War Museum at Historic Tredegar Two floors of exhibits will take you on a journey from the very beginning of the Civil War to Reconstruction and beyond. Located in downtown Richmond on the James River, the museum sits on the site of the Tredegar Iron Works. Cannons made at Tredegar fired the first shots of the Civil War at Fort Sumter. The thick armor plating that protected the ironclad CSS Virginia (Merrimack) during its fight with the Monitor was rolled at Tredegar. More than half of the cannon used by the Confederate army were cast here.

White House of the Confederacy - Built in 1818, this National Historic Landmark served as the Confederate Executive Mansion during the war. Guided tours of the restored house—the elegant public rooms as well as the private living quarters—explore the lives of the people who lived and worked there.

House Tour at Agecroft Hall & Gardens

Agecroft Hall is a 15th-century Tudor-style home and was moved from England in 1925 and rebuilt on the banks of the James River. The grounds and gardens reflect the glorious style of England's Tudor and early Stuart periods.

Lunch on own in Carytown

Carytown, nestled in the heart of Richmond, with a focus on small, locally owned businesses, is a unique shopping, dining, and entertainment district offers more than 16 restaurants. Save room for dessert! Carytown has three candy stores, four ice cream shops, two bakeries, and three cupcake shops, all tucked between charming boutiques and galleries.
