The Philadelphia Flower Show

The PHS Philadelphia Flower Show is both the nation's largest and the world's longest-running horticultural event, featuring stunning displays by premier floral and landscape designers from around the globe. Started in 1829 by the Pennsylvania Horticultural Society, the Show introduces diverse and sustainable plant varieties and garden and design concepts. In addition to acres of garden displays, the Flower Show hosts esteemed competitions in horticulture and artistic floral arranging, gardening presentations and demonstrations, and special events.

The Philadelphia Flower Show has been honored as the best overall event in the world by the International Festivals & Events Association, competing with events such as the Kentucky Derby Festival, Tournament of Roses Parade, Indianapolis 500 Festival, and other international celebrations.

Where to Eat: Food can be purchased at the Flower Show throughout the Pennsylvania Convention Center. There are Snack Bars at the rear of the main exhibit hall, and full dining services location on Level 3 above the exhibition halls in the Overlook Café. You will also find numerous restaurants in the area immediately surrounding the Convention Center, including Reading Terminal Market and in nearby Chinatown. **Free Re-entry:** Visitors can re-enter the show on the same day free. Need to have hand stamped.

Handicap Accessibility: The Pennsylvania Convention Center is a handicap accessible building. Elevators are available to guests who require them. Wheelchairs are available for rent on a first-come first-served basis.

Visitor Suggestions:

- Dress for the occasion – There is a lot to see, so comfortable shoes are a must. Dress in layers as it can get chilly on the Show floor.
- Take notes - Jot down the name of plants you like or the contact information of exhibitors, or snap a photo of your favorite exhibits.
