Cape Henry Lighthouse (*Photo ID is required for all over the age 16*)

While the original Cape Henry Lighthouse is the 4th oldest lighthouse in the country, it was the first lighthouse authorized by the U.S. government, dating from 1792. It was the first federal construction project authorized by President George Washington after the Revolutionary War. In 1881, a newer lighthouse was constructed 350 feet from the original. The Cape Henry Lighthouse has long served to protect and guide vessels entering and leaving the Chesapeake Bay. Today two lighthouses stand at Cape Henry, guardians to the gateway of the Chesapeake Bay.

Whether you're a Norfolk local or you're visiting for the first time, you're sure to learn something about the harbor on this interesting tour. Your captain shares history and facts during the first hour, and you can just enjoy the tranquility of sailing during the second hour.

It's a lively atmosphere on Scope Plaza with Tattoo cast out of uniform and performing tunes of their own selection. You will see returning favorites including Switzerland's **Top Secret Drum Corps** and the **Netherlands Royal Marine Band** and first time performers that are sure to become new favorites. Not to be forgotten are the **Massed Pipes and Drums** from 4 nations who will be joined by the incredible **Virginia International Tattoo Highland Dance Company**.
The soul of the 2024 Tattoo will be an emotional and grateful **Celebration of Freedom**, 80 years from the D-Day landings and 75 years from the founding of NATO. This Tattoo will remind us that as Americans, we have helped write some of the greatest chapters in the story of human freedom. With stirring music, historic photos and video, tributes from US military bands and appearances by special guests, we will remember and celebrate the men and women who have safeguarded freedom not only for the United States, but for the world.
