The Fisher One-Room School is attached to the house and filled with authentic desks and furnishings from an actual Amish school. You'll learn the tradition of teaching eight grades in one room. From the pantry stocked full of freshly canned vegetables to the family's plain clothes... from propane-powered lamps to air-compressor driven appliances...the Amish Country Homestead truly provides insights into the complex riddles of a culture so very different from your own.

Fishers Amish In-Home Meal

Enjoy a traditional Amish family-style meal, served at the home of an Amish neighbor. A typical menu is: Pot Roast (Beef) with Gravy, Baked Chicken (Leg & Thigh), Glazed Ham Balls, Tossed Salad, Broccoli & Cauliflower Salad, Mashed Potatoes, Green Bean Casserole, Apple Pie with Icing, Shoofly Pie, coffee and meadow tea. **Note:** The Amish home is not handicap accessible.

Kitchen Kettle Village

With a range, 30 kettles, and a half-dozen recipes a jelly business was born in 1954.

Located in the little town of Intercourse. It boasts unique shops, where artisans and artisans sell their country wares. The village consists of over 40 shops and restaurants.
