The estate, gardens, and farm of Mount Vernon totaled some 8,000 acres in the 18th century. Presently, an estimated 500 acres of this historic property have been painstakingly preserved along the banks of the Potomac River.

George Washington's Mansion is ten times the size of the average home in colonial Virginia. Inside the Mansion, guests can see: the New Room, the grandest space in the house, the Key to the Bastille, given to George Washington by the Marquis de Lafayette in 1790, family portraits and the Washington coat of arms, Washington's private study

The Steven F. Udvar-Hazy Center near Washington Dulles International Airport is the companion facility to the museum in Washington, D.C. Hundreds of historically significant air- and spacecraft, along with thousands of small artifacts, are on display in an open, hangar-like setting. Other features of the Center include the Donald D. Engen Observation Tower, the Airbus IMAX Theater, and the Mary Baker Engen Restoration Hangar, where visitors can watch museum specialists at work restoring artifacts.
