Learn about the wooden boats and steamers that travelled the lake and the hungers, fishermen and Native Americans who have flocked to the beautiful Lakes region for centuries.

Maine Forestry Museum

Dedicated to the celebration of the lumbering heritage of the Western Maine Mountain. A tour is provided here with fascinating stories of how the lumbermen made their living and the saws and equipment they used. You'll also see a lumberman art collection and a bunkhouse.
