Journey Behind the Falls – timed entrance with group

To stand at the heart of Niagara, you'll first need to descend 150 feet and explore 130-year-old tunnels through the bedrock, but you'll feel the thunderous vibration of the Horseshoe Falls long before you see them. The observation deck at the foot of this 13-story-tall wonder will leave you breathless (and maybe a little bit wet), but don't forget the viewing portals cut straight through the rock, offering a once-in-a-lifetime view of one-fifth of the world's fresh water crashing down in front of you.

Hornblower Niagara Boat Ride – timed entrance with group

You may have seen the Falls before but you've never seen them quite like this. Hold onto your heart and keep your eyes wide open because you're in for the thrill of a lifetime! The legendary Niagara Falls boat tour takes you as close as possible to the thundering roar, awesome power and amazing mist of the mighty Falls!

Afternoon on own – optional activities on Niagara Falls Pass (included)

Enjoy the afternoon on your own. Your **Niagara Falls Pass** also includes a 48 Hour Falls Incline pass, Niagara's Power Station and 48-Hour WEGO transportation. The admissions are included on the pass, and are to be used at your own leisure.

## Dinner included at Skylon Tower – Summit Suite Buffet

The Skylon Tower is Niagara Falls most famous restaurant. The restaurant offers fine dining 775 feet above the Falls! You can see the Canadian Horseshoe Falls, The American Falls and the Bridal Veil Falls all from the restaurants and observation deck. Visibility from Observatory on a clear day is 80 miles.

### Day 3      Thursday (B)

Breakfast at hotel

White Water Walk – timed entrance with group

Take a walk like no other, along a boardwalk at the very edge of one of the world's wildest stretches of whitewater! Marvel at the relentless power and beauty of nature, and see how the deep and narrow Great Gorge was created. Trillions of gallons of water are forced into this accelerating trough--the sight will take your breath away!

Whirlpool Aero Car – timed entrance with group

Soar the Great Gorge, high above the racing Niagara River. You'll be transported through the air in an antique cable car, while far below the torrent of water abruptly changes direction and creates one of the world's most mesmerizing natural phenomena - the Niagara Whirlpool, sometimes frightening and always unforgettable!

Floral Clock

The intricate designs on the face of the Floral Clock are created with up to 16,000 carpet bedding plants and are changed twice each year. The planted face of the Floral Clock is maintained by the Niagara Parks horticulture staff, while the mechanism inside is kept in working order by Ontario Hydro. The tower at the back of the clock houses Westminster chimes that greet each quarter hour.

Afternoon and time on own at Niagara-on-the-Lake

Nestled in the corner of the Niagara Region just beyond Niagara Falls, the picturesque Niagara-on-the-Lake epitomizes old town charm. Known by the locals as NOTL, this must visit village is bordered on both sides by waterfront with arbour-framed streets among lush boulevard gardens. Wander through the Heritage District as you discover whimsical boutiques, enthralling antique shops and delightful bistros - maybe even a horse drawn carriage or two.

Return to hotel – dinner and evening on own
