Housed in the 1863 Mansion of New York State's 22nd Governor, Reuben E. Fenton, The Fenton History Center is all about what makes the area great, from local history exhibits, to a reference/genealogy library.

Luncheon Cruise aboard the Chautauqua Belle

Our Historical Tour tells of the late 1800's time period, when Chautauqua was in its infancy. Listen as we tell you about Henry Ford, Harvey Firestone, Lewis Miller, and many other industrialists of the era, which vacationed during the summer months in this utopian community.
