Completed in 1805, Poplar Hill Mansion is Salisbury's oldest house and serves as a museum with exhibits about historic architecture and furnishings, medical practices of the early 1800s, farming in the early 1800s, life of the enslaved people, and Salisbury history.

Assateague's wild horses are well known, even to many people who have never been to the island. The "wild" horses on Assateague are actually feral animals, meaning that they are descendants of domestic animals that have reverted to a wild state. Horses tough enough to survive the scorching heat, abundant mosquitoes, stormy weather and poor quality food found on this remote, windswept barrier island have formed a unique wild horse society. Enjoy their beauty from a distance, and you can help make sure these extraordinary wild horses will continue to thrive on Assateague Island.

Enjoy this 80 minute cruise aboard the Assateague Adventure II and see the wild ponies in their natural habitat, bird watch, learn about the eco system, and the fishing boats and navigate Ocean City's commercial fishing boat harbor.

The museum offers visitors a chance to do a deep dive into the history of the U.S. Life-Saving Service and learn about the cultural and natural history of Ocean City and Worcester County, Maryland.
