The Mall serves as Cape May's town square, and features numerous benches, luscious gardens, shady trees, historical markers, gas lamps, bistro-style string lights, Instagram-worthy photo opportunities, and more.

**Mansions by the Sea – Trolley Tour**

Don't be green with envy on this trolley tour when you see how well the rich lived in the early 1900s in the most elegant part of town. You'll see the broad streets and summer "mansions" of Cape May's east side on this trolley tour – an area marketed as "New Cape May" at the turn of the 20th Century.
