Guided tour of Portland

Upon arrival you will meet your local guide for a narrated tour of Portland – Maine’s largest city-by-the-sea. You’ll travel through the historic neighborhoods, learn about Portland’s unique maritime history, pass by Longfellow’s boyhood home and many sea captain mansions overlooking Casco Bay. Your tour includes “the lighthouse loop” with a stop at Portland Head lighthouse, the most photographed lighthouse in America and Maine’s oldest beacon, set in a beautiful park with crashing surf as a backdrop along with Spring Point Lighthouse and Bug Lighthouse.

Lunch and time on own in Portland’s historic waterfront district

Grab lunch on own along cobblestone streets in Portland’s historic waterfront district, the Old Port Exchange. Here you can enjoy views of Casco Bay while enjoying lunch or browse through the quaint shops selling crafts, antiques, and Maine-made products.

Check into hotel One (1) Night
Boothbay Harbor Inn
Dinner on own this evening

The hotel is located on "the quiet side" of Boothbay, just a short stroll from downtown across a charming footbridge beside the hotel. The footbridge that connects to the “downtown” center of Boothbay Harbor where there are many shops and art galleries to explore.

Scenic Harbor & Nature Cruise

Enjoy a scenic Harbor & Nature cruise on Linekin Bay this morning. You'll pass by beautiful vacation homes, lighthouses, small islands, the seals on the ledges and the puffin birds that summer here on Eastern Egg Rock. Truly a magnificent "Seafari" for all nature lovers with seals, blue heron, an occasional whale and other coastal wildlife along the way.

Maine Lobstering Cruise

Learn how the Maine lobstermen make their living as traps are hauled from the ocean along the rocky coast of Kennebunkport.. See the sights as you cruise on the ocean past Walkers Point, the Dark Shadows House and Bumpkin Island, home to a year-round colony of sea birds and seals.

Free time for shopping and lunch on own in Dock Square

Dock Square is the vibrant, central hub of Kennebunkport, Maine, situated on the Kennebunk River and known for its shops, restaurants, and art galleries. It features a mix of historic fishing shacks and modern establishments, offering a lively atmosphere with a variety of boutiques, eateries, and places to find local crafts and souvenirs. Visitors can enjoy waterfront views, shopping and dining.

Guided tour of Kennebunk & Kennebunkport

Take a narrated riding tour through the villages of Kennebunk and Kennebunkport. Drive past the sandy beaches and rocky coastline, past the George Bush estate at Walker's Point, hear the history of these shipbuilding towns and the legend of the Wedding Cake House. You'll also visit the seaside Franciscan Monastery with its beautiful landscaping, outdoor shrines and chapel.

Built in 1879, Cape Neddick is the southernmost of Maine's many lights. It is also known as Nubble Light, referring to the barren and rocky ledge (the Nubble) on which it sits.
