45 Minute Sightseeing Cruise on Skaneateles Lake

Skaneateles (ski-nee-at-luhs) Lake or “Long Lake” is one of the highest Finger Lakes, sitting 863 ft. above sea level. The lake is 16 miles long and 1 mile wide. In the early 1800s, many settlers were attracted to the land surrounding Skaneateles Lake because they were able to use the lake outlet as a power source for water mills and other types of early industry. Enjoy this 50 minute sightseeing cruise as it takes you approximately 3 miles down the East side of the lake to return on the West side where you’ll see many stately homes, old and new, The Sherwood Inn, originally a stagecoach stop, and steep and wooded hill sides at the southern end.

**Day 2      Wednesday (B,D)**

Muranda Cheese Company – Cheese Tasting

Muranda Cheese Company features the finest in cow’s milk pasteurized cheeses. Their most sought after varieties include British Cheddar, Red Buddy, and Muranda Blue, as well as many other varieties not commonly found in the Finger Lakes, but whose bold, full flavors you’d expect to come from this region.

**Rose Hill Mansion**

Experience a taste of life on a 19th-century estate when you visit this National Historic Landmark. Built in 1839, the elegant Greek Revival house was the center of a busy and productive farm by mid-century. Much of the tour focuses on the Swan family, in residence from 1850-1890. Through family letters, photographs, and diaries, explore the family's joys and sorrows and their interactions with neighbors and the many workers required to keep the large house and farm in working order.

Seward House Museum

The Seward House in *Auburn, New York* is a historic and beautifully preserved early-19th-century home that now serves as a museum dedicated to the life and legacy of William Henry Seward, one of the most influential American politicians of his era. It was built in 1816–1817 as a ten-room townhouse for Cayuga County Judge Elijah Miller and later became the home of William H. Seward after his marriage to Miller’s daughter, Frances. The museum interprets not just Seward’s political achievements—such as his role in the Alaska purchase and abolitionist causes—but also his family’s local impact and broader *19th-century American life*

Guided Tour at Willard Memorial Chapel

The Willard Memorial Chapel is an architectural and artistic treasure, celebrated as one of the finest and most complete surviving works of Louis Comfort Tiffany. It was built between 1886 and 1892 and designed by renowned architect Andrew Jackson Warner, with Tiffany and his firm responsible for nearly every interior element—making it a rare, unified example of the Aesthetic Movement in America. Inside, visitors are immersed in a jewel-like space featuring; Tiffany stained glass windows, rich glass mosaics, ornate stenciled walls and ceilings and custom-designed lighting fixtures, furniture, and decorative details.
