Provincetown is at the northern tip of Cape Cod, Massachusetts. The seaside town is on the site of the Mayflower's landing in 1620, commemorated by the towering Pilgrim Monument and neighboring Provincetown Museum. Numerous galleries plus restaurants, nightclubs, cabarets and specialty shops are clustered on and around lively Commercial Street.

## Art's Dune Tours

Imagine dunes stretching as far as you can see with wispy beach grass, dark green pine trees and deep red beach plums nestled in hollows which are brought together by a silhouette of blue sky. You will travel through the majestic dunes where your guide points out the "dune shacks" where famous artists and writers like Eugene O'Neill and Harry Kemp became inspired to create their art. You will also pass the remains of the Peaked Hill Life Saving Station and learn how the brave "life savers" enacted their heroic efforts to save the lives of thousands from the doomed shipwrecks. You will be amazed at what you will see on this incredibly scenic sand dune tour.

Whale Watch Cruise

Provincetown, Massachusetts is one of the premier marine wildlife experiences on the East Coast. Trips depart and head out into Cape Cod Bay and toward the rich feeding grounds of the Stellwagen Bank National Marine Sanctuary, an area known for abundant whale activity and some of the best whale watching in the Atlantic.

Sandwich Glass Museum

The Sandwich Historical Society and its Glass Museum collects, preserves, and interprets the history of the Town of Sandwich, MA, the oldest town on Cape Cod. A large part of Sandwich history is involved with American glass production. The Sandwich Glass Museum has "Relit the Fires in Sandwich" with a glass furnace for hourly glass making presentations and new exhibits to better tell the story of the glass industry in Sandwich. Watch the glassblower turn and twist the hot glass into wonderful forms, and visions of those former days will not be so difficult to understand or imagine.
